

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
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NEWS SEPTEMBER 2011

2. DESIGNER MAKES DRESSES FROM BALLOONS.

The balloon artist Rie Hosokai, who has combined balloon art and fashion, has brought her designs to the runway with great success.

"You can wow people at parties or weddings with a balloon dress. They'll be surprised, "Hosokai said. A party dress needs about 200 balloons, with each balloon costing about \$0.09. After the design and creation of a dress, they cost between \$1,930 and \$3.860.

The theme of the HERMES Spring/ Summer 2011 collection is Mexico. Traditional embroidery of the Otomi Indians, who live in the Tenango in Mexico, has been adopted for the design of a new scarf. This motif features a traditional myth in which an animal and plant appear. Until their design was used by HERMES, the indigenous people's lives were very difficult. Funds gained from this design have been used to help the local people.

7. ALL CHINA LEATHER EXHIBITION (ACLE)



The stunning Emily Grace Bathgate has been a fixture on the Australian fashion scene, as a model and coveted stylist. Now, she has launched a Perth-based fashion label onto Perth fashion scene with her debut collection: 'romanticism' spring/summer 2011-12.

What motivated you to make the transition from stylist to designer?

I've been styling for a couple of years now and, before that, I was modelling for around three years. I've always loved just about everything that is fashion, but I think I was prompted to start designing when I got involved in fashion styling: I began to truly discover my own personal style, what I like and don't like, and I realised that there was nothing around that truly suited my own style, my lifestyle and my budget!

So, "With Grace" is the perfect solution to a common problem: the hunt for affordable yet luxe-looking pieces with enough individuality and exclusivity.

What do you miss about styling?

I'm still stylina!

Styling is definitely one of my passions, and I love to express my creativity, my artistic flair and my imagination through what happens to be my favourite medium: fashion! I love working with such incredibly talented and creative people, with ideas bouncing back and forth between everyone, and I love the creative control styling brings. I suppose styling is, for me, like playing with my Barbies again. I'm dressing pretty ladies

Barbies again. I'm dressing pretty ladies in pretty outfits as an adult, and yet it's still as fun as it was back when I was five or six!

How is your label unique?

I saw a gap in the market for vintage-inspired women's wear with a unique, contemporary and ever-stylish twist. Basically, I was tired of my own chosen style of dress being limited by finances and great distances, and I knew that other people would be in the same boat. Enter "With Grace" with its affordable, yet luxe and distinctive, pieces!

"With Grace" is designed with my styling experience in mind. This results in a collection full of pieces that are incredibly wearable, both individually and with other pieces from the same collection.

Each piece is considered with an overall outfit in mind: an outfit that will set the wearer apart from the crowd. leave



How would you describe your designs & who is your label's customer?

The "With Grace" aesthetic is best described as elegant bohemian – each piece tells the tale of another time and place, gives the wearer a great feeling of setapartness, and guarantees to turn heads!

The "With Grace" woman is sentimental in spirit, fashion forward in thinking, and Grace-ful in nature. While elegant and sophisticated in dressing,

she also appreciates the bohemian image embraced by times past, and gets the combination just right inspired by vintage styles, and the collection's really a liberating celebration of the treasures from 'way back when'. I tried to combine modern-day trends into each piece; each garment telling a story from a faraway time and place, while staying relevant to today's women of style – their tastes, their lifestyles, their inspirations. With obvious parallels with the popular styles of the 70s, this collection also shows hints of neat and tailored silhouettes: morsels of simplicity mixed with the easy-floatiness of that sought - after 70s style. These looks embody both then & now, yet still maintain a real freshness and individuality.

How do to start designing a new season/what inspires you?

As a stylist and general fan of all things fashion, I'm constantly submerging myself in inspiring environs. From fashion magazines to reference books in my local library, outstanding projects produced by my peers and friends, to overseas catwalk shows, creating my Book of Inspiration is one of my favourite things to do. My book inspires my styling work and my designing, and, as a very visual and creative person, I'd be lost without it!

Style-wise, I have a huge admiration for quite a few women. I always love what Kate Bosworth, Erin Wasson, Chloe Sevigny and Gwyneth Paltrow are wearing. I suppose a combination of all of their styles forms an explanation of my own style. I also have a huge respect for the stylish women of years gone by, famous or not. I think there can always be something learnt from reading about them, and I love reading quotes by Madame Coco Chanel.

Thoughts on Japan and style there...

I have a huge admiration for Japanese fashionistas! The one word that springs to mind is definitely 'fun', and I think that if you can have fun with your style and your way of dress, that makes you a truly stylish person.

I've never been to Japan, but it's certainly a place on my list of dream adventures. I'm a bit of a nerd really, and I love learning about the history of other cultures on my holidays, as well as sampling modern day cultures too - so not just shopping!



Shanghai Fashion

Christan is an up-and-coming designer in Shanghai. A recent graduate of the esteemed Raffles Design Institute, she was recently selected to be one of their top designers to take part in their special Raffles "Privato" project, promoting "designed in China" local Shanghai fashion talent.



En Vie: Please introduce yourself to our readers!

Christan: I come from Shaoshan, Hunan Province, it is a historical place, as you know, Chairman Mao came from my home town. Three years ago, I came to Shanghai and I saw this school - this school's lifestyle and this School's teachers and the education is of a different style, very international, so I studied here for three years and now I'm doing this fashion collection.

En Vie: Why are you so interested in Fashion?

Christan: When I was a little girl, I liked to use dress up with things like sheets or my grandmother's clothes and I would do some, not quite designs, but DIY things. I was really interested in this sort of thing when I was a child.

En Vie: How old are we talking?

Christan: Seven. I liked to wear my grandmothers clothes. They were so big. I had to tie them up.





En Vie: So, you became interested in fashion, but there are many fashion schools, so what was your reason for picking Raffles Design Institute (sh.raffles.edu.cn)?

Christan: Firstly, the lifestyle. At this school you can do anything by yourself. It's not like a traditional chinese school where a traditional chinese school teacher tells what to do each day, step by step. By doing this, I really learned to do everything by myself and built confidence. The other reason is that teachers here don't just give me knowledge but the also give me ideas, this is very important, and maybe chinese traditional schools couldn't do that.

En Vie: You have the knowledge of how to make these clothes, but you also need to be inspired by something.

Christan: My inspiration? Everyone asks me this question. For this collection I chose Shanghai in the 1930s. Since I studied in Shanghai for 3 years I am very interested in the city's fashion style – the ladies' elegance. So I tried to express that.

In this collection I wanted to represent the lifestyle of old Shanghai people. In one of the pieces, a top with full, long sleeves, it was designed to be worn in many different ways. This was because the people in old Shanghai had no taxis or cars in the 1930s, only rickshaws, so people had to carry many things tied to their bodies. That is why western clothes always had these parts you could tie around the waist, because that was the lifestyle of poor people in the 1930s in Shanghai.

As for colours, I like red, purple, pink, those kinds of colours. I think these colours give me warmth, and I chose this wool because it was given to me by my grandmother so it is also very warm. I think that the green I used here is a really old fashioned green, so it gives a sense of nostalgia.

En Vie: Do you check out a lot of photos from this time?

Christan: I like to use these details. But for the shape, of course I want to make it modern, this is fashion, not a history museum, so the shape is always modern and sexy and cool. But the details, are traditional, like the fabric I used for the piping, I used a special kind of Chinese silk. This silk was used a long time ago, so by using this silk it really evokes this time.

En Vie: Where do you see China in the world of fashion?


Christan: I think China is experiencing a turning point in its fashion industry, It seems that as the country becomes wealthier, people's ideas of shopping are focusing more on the design and not just on the brand. They want to see fresh designs from local chinese designers, because each suit or dress has its own story behind its design. There are lots of opportunities for young people to develop their own businesses or designs here.


En Vie: What are you planning for the future?


Christan: At present I am working on the Raffles Privato and I have to have to work on the collections for the next season, so we are working all out to finish the Raffles project right now.

And then? I'm still young, so if I can develop my own business or maybe study abroad or if a famous enterprise would like to hire me I would try my best to make the most of any opportunities that arise, whatever they are.



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




Jeans like no others

Having opened their first store in China on Changle Road, "haso-jeans" is counting now 8 stores in the country (Shanghai Raffles, Shanghai Changle, Hangzhou Tower, Chungking NOVO, Shenyang NOVO and Beijing NOVO).


With their original custom-made jeans, using concepts such as "play on jeans", "you are the one" and "idea generation", haso-jeans offers to their customers the possibility to personalize pattern, tone, stitch, rivet, button and label. The texture can be chosen from Okayama indigodyeing jean, organic jean, Zimbabwe coton jean, Supima cotton jean and many others.

A custom-made "haso-jeans" takes 7 to 10 days to be made and costs from 1000RMB to 2680RMB.

Besides the custom-made jeans, original items by European, Japanese and Chinese designers are on display at "haso-jeans" stored.




scales, glowing like a firefly and she has never seen anything as beautiful as this dress.



In Kyoto, the old capital city of Japan, through the sound of Gion Matsuri and Konchikichin both people and the gods resonate together.

In September 2009, the Gion Matsuri Yamaboko (Mountain Spear) procession was officially recorded by UNESCO and given global recognition for its value as an 'intangible cultural asset'.

UNESCO states that 'intangible cultural assets' are items of 'living heritage' that have taken place over a long time, and have been passed on from successive generation to generation. Gion Matsuri has changed in time over the past thousand years, to eventually become the festival that it is today.

Originally the festival was for praying for the eradication of infectious diseases, but in time it came to be that the towns of Muromachi and Hokomachi competed against each other as to who had the better decorated float procession.

This led to the float surroundings and decorations being made from many precious goods ordered from places such as China, Korea, Europe, India and Persia. Ultimately leading to the festival being dubbed the 'World's Moving Art Museum'.

Rather than the spear, the focus shifted to the applause and approval of the refined Kyoto audience, a trend later adopted elsewhere for other festivals. In the Yamaboko procession, every god and religion could be praised as 'a god of Gion Matsuri'.

The rhythm of the Konchikichin procession was passed on in the bloodlines of the pioneers and ancestors, promoting to the rest of the world the beauty of Kyoto, Japan and one of Japan's most prominent festivals.





Style Points

Simple straight hair, rough in texture yet set into a chignon style

Styling Instructions

- 1. Lightly twist hair around curling irons
- **2.** Take a large zigzag parting, holding at the back and build hair simply on top of itself
- **3.** Using a hair band, separate some hair from the back and twist at the base to wrap and set around a hairpin.
- **4.** From the outside of the bun, take separate small sections of hair with your fingers and roughly pull down
- **5.** Insert a decorative hairpin and add a light amount of hairspray to set and finish

Coordinating with a Yukata
