
around the theme of breakfast.



That's how Wade Livingston talks about why he loves his job. He is an excellent photographer with twenty years of experience and still many ideas on his mind. He owns a private studio in Dallas, Texas, where he experiments and focuses on his work. Wade is always in motion with the purpose to get as many fashion editorials and campaigns as he can, so that he can do what he lives for.

He is a versatile artist, and we can say the same about the locations and the themes that he shoots. In the studio, as well as in the wild, he seems to be able to capture the best of every scene by using a different

approach to each campaign. Among the studio works we find is Nightfall, the set of which was inspired by a Mexican movie from the 40's and 50's. The model was Hispanic so the role of a Mexican movie star really suited her. For this shooting, Wade took advantage of the afternoon and then the evening waning sunlight in the first shots and for the others he gradually introduced tungsten lightning. One of his best and latest open-air works on the other hand is "Black Swan", which took place by a river. Of course the subject, along with the model and her dresses, is the water. Like a swan, the ambience of these two protagonists melt together with elegance, expressing all the gracefulness of this animal, and black as the jet black hair of the model. Wade Livingston definitely has a gift and I am sure that his contributions to the world of fashion photography will become more and more significant.



What inspired you to do this shoot?

What are the best part and the hardest part of the underwater shooting?

The entire shoot was absolutely amazing. We all had so much fun. Probably the only difficult part was to get all the hair and the dress materials to stay the way we wanted them to and for the light to look really natural.

Are there any messages that you wanted to deliver to the audiences with this series of photos?

goal was to make a fashion shoot, but so that the images have the sense of lightness and elegance. Like frozen moments of zero-gravity. I hope we achieved it well.

Actually, I am always planning new projects; I just can't stop my mind from thinking! There are so many inspirations out there! I guess it's just because I love


What do you care the most about when you're taking photographs?

For me the most important part while shooting is that everyone involved is feeling good and having a really nice time. If you feel comfortable while working, you give even more than 100%. Mostly when I start a shoot I have some basic ideas, how my outcome should/would look like, but then I let myself get inspired from the model, the location, the makeup.. and in the end, the results turn out to be something totally different than the first idea quite often. I love this part. Surprising yourself can be quite challenging!














The iconic flamenco aress, used and all de Sevilla festivities, is a beautiful, figurehe iconic flamenco dress, used during the Feria enhancing dress that originally was used by the wives of farmers that attended the cattle fair. Since then both the fair and the dresses have evolved into a more festive occasion.

There are very few regional costumes worldwide that follow fashion and change from year to year .Seville has a unique flamenco fashion catwalk event every year, where the newest trends are shown. More than 20 designers show their creations and usually there are around 60 stands with not only flamenco dresses, but also fabrics, shoes and accessories.

This year it is fashionable to wear uneven ruffles mixed in sizes and shapes, long sleeves and pastel colours. Prints are either monochromatic or bold designs, no middle point and almost no dot patterns, which is the most traditional print for Flamenco dresses.

Flamenco dresses are figure hugging and make every woman look fabulous, no matter their size or shape.

Accessories give the whole look its final touch. Huge golden loops or bejeweled hair combs, plenty of flowers pinned on luscious locks , sometimes mid-hair are some of this year's proposals. Also very important is the "mantoncillo", a small scarf that will give the dress movement when dancing.

The "Mantones de Manila" are often worn cleverly pinned as a dress but usually are used as a garment

Her natural beauty and simplicity leads her to creating every day and her inner beauty radiates everywhere; she truly believes in spiritual energies, such as Buddhism and Hinduism.

All the best materials are used for her jewelries, such as gold, silver, brass and copper. The minerals, which come from all over the world, are a mixture of faceted and raw stones set in 925 sterling silver, 18K and 22K gold and occasionally platinum.

Students have established their own brands with concepts and target groups, and created practical clothes which are ready to wear in town. The students' creations were to be judged by the guest judges from major apparel companies and department stores in Japan, and the judges gave them sometimes harsh, but very practical feedback so that they will know what to expect and how to survive in the very competitive fashion world after they graduate.


There were 10 brands and each brand had their own feature and uniqueness; all of them were very creative yet practical so that we could easily imagine people walking on the street in their clothes. "Edel" offered very simple and clean styles with white blouses and flower print pants or pleated high-waist skirts, as well as some sets of tweed one-piece dresses. "Fairy Tale" presented adorable light brown plaid puffy skirts with tutu underneath, and some short puff sleeve shirts. As

models danced in their clothes, they literally looked like fairies. Meanwhile, there was a very sporty, unisex brand "MARCHE". They used polyester jersey materials, mainly in black and white with very bright neon blue and green as accent colors.

After the fashion show, they moved their clothes to the exhibition room where the students got to present and appeal their creations directly to the judges. The evaluation system was just like a real fashion buying exhibition. The judges visited each booth with student assistants and decided what they would like to purchase for the season under a fixed budget of JPY 500,000. Students seemed to be excited and passionate about their first experience in the fashion business despite the pressure and possibility that their creations might get harshly criticized. The eyes of the judges were as serious as the students', but all participants seemed to enjoy this rare opportunity overall.

The students' ability to design and create beautiful pieces was obvious and to be highly evaluated. With this precious opportunity to experience what it's like to be in the fashion business, they more prepared for the next stage of their careers. Now it is time for them to leave the nest and take a step forward into the fashion world.









INISA'S IAPPY SVEETS

APRIL RECIPE 1: VITAMIN-RICH KIWI SODA





Ingredients

2 kiwis
A bit of lemon
Caster sugar to taste (about 1 tablespoon)
Carbonated water (sugarless)

Recipe

Peel the kiwis and blend them into a pulp using a blender, then pour into a glass, add the soda and a squeeze of lemon.

- * If using carbonated water with sugar in it, no additional sugar needs to be added.

APRIL RECIPE 2: CHOCOLATE MILLE CRÊPE

Several layers of lightly fried crepes with ganache in between for a classic, rustic taste. The chewy feel of the crepe matches perfectly with the ganache.



Ingredients

Crêpe batter
Flour: 60g
Salt: one pinch
Egg: 1
Milk: 200cc
Butter: 15g
Cooking oil: a small

Ganache
Chocolate: 80g
Cream: 40cc
Rum Raisins: 50g

Cocoa powder (for finish): to taste



Recipe

Crêpe

- 1. Break and beat the eggs in a bowl, then pour in milk that is about body temperature. Add sugar and salt and mix so that is does not clump.
- $2.\,\mbox{Mix}$ in melted butter and let cool in the refrigerator for about one hour.
- 3. Spread a thin layer of cooking oil on a frying pan and place over medium heat. Pour the crêpe batter in and spread into a round shape with a ladle. Fry both sides to the point that the surface is dry. Continue to fry more of the same size.



Ganache

- 1. Finely chop up the chocolate and place it into a bowl, then pour in the cream just before it comes to a boil
- 2. Stir with a spatula until smooth, then when it melts completely, place in the refrigerator for about 15 minutes until it becomes hard enough to spread easily.

Finis

- 1. Spread a layer of the ganache about 1mm thick onto the crêpe with a spatula.
- 2. Sprinkle the rum raisins in the middle, placing them into the ganache.
- 3. Continue applying layers, sprinkling cocoa powder on each layer and then on top to finish.
