
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

The taste of his kiss lingered on my lips.



He worked as a software engineer for thirty years for companies like IBM, Texaco and American Airlines before he switched careers and made his longtime hobby his profession. He originally began focusing on architecture and landscape photography but soon came to realise that his ultimate interests lie in fashion, hair and beauty. He provides photography services for hair shoots, bridal portraits, corporate head-shots, and model portfolio developments.


The majority of Williams' work concentrates on individual models in a simple setting. He usually chooses to frame the model against a neutral or plain background, emphasising her natural features and giving her scope to experiment with different moods. His images of red-haired Katie Lopez in a yellow and white crochet dress and a braided updo are particularly clean and fresh.


Williams has produced work for 'Not Just A Label', 'The Photographer Link', 'Fashion Network Seattle', 'Dstripped Magazine', 'Pink Polish', 'Smashing Darling', 'Nuave World', and 'Posh Couture'. His summertime images of Brazilian model Nivea Zacarkim, decked out in large sun hats and neutral makeup, have been featured on the Benjamin Kanarek blog.

Williams has also shot the look-book for the environmentally-conscious brand K. Hendrix. The label is designed by Kimberley Hendrix, a Project Runway casting finalist. All her pieces are handmade and have been created from quality vintage materials. The 2011 look-book features model Roxanne Jewel Yaist in shredded fabrics and boiled sequins. Williams highlights the unique, flawed nature of this 'remade' clothing by shooting Roxanne against a distressed brick wall, cracked concrete and washed-out window panes.


out of every day as if it were the last one. Love can be a compelling culprit!

However, the spectacle of romance is to be embraced and celebrated. As she keeps waiting and anticipating his love, she believes he will be back...soon.



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
ince the early 1990's grunge, punk, and metal has made its mark on fashion. Through studs, flannels, and acid wash denim a new era of unconventional individuality was built. Along side, studded vests, dresses, and custom pieces REVIVALS is grunge wear that fits in the modern closet. Each piece is hand crafted and one of a kind just like the music that has inspired them. Colored denim and studded shoulder pads give REVIVALS designs and youthful look that will last for years to come. The nostalgia of reliving a period of carelessness through a revived jacket is what fashion and music are truly about.

Grunge fashion has defined a culture of carelessness and independence. Today that culture continues on and it is apparent through the fashion. A mixture of texture and patterns, layered through; maxi skirts, over sized sweaters, and an old rock n' roll tee, scream the same reckless lifestyle that Curt Cobain screamed in his music. AUGUST RECIPE: WHITE PEACH SHORTCAKE (12CM DIAMETER)

A simple cake with the sweet and sour yet refreshing aroma of white peach.



Ingredients

Genovese Spongecake 60g flour 2 whole eggs 60g granulated sugar

Pre-Preparation

1. Peel and cut the peach, remove the pit, and sprinkle with lemon juice (to adjust the color) 2. Melt the butter in a hot water bath. 3. Line the with baking paper. 4. Pre-heat the oven to 150.

20g butter

20g sugar

200cc cream

1/2 white peach

Recipe

 Mix the eggs and sugar in a bowl and whisk in a hot water bath until it starts to thicken.
Add flour and mix quickly.
Gradually pour the dough into the melted butter and mix it together. Then pour the batter into the original bowl.
Pour it into the pan lined with baking paper (12cm diameter), and bake for 20 minutes at 150. no cake sticks to it, remove it from the oven and chill. 6. Pour the cream and sugar in a bowl and whip for 8 minutes in an ice bath. 7. Once the sponge cake has cooled, slice horizontally into three pieces and place the cream and peaches between the slices. 8. Cover the outside with cream and decorations, adding toppings such as mint and peaches to your liking




