




#### 2 MADONNA CHAMPIONS YEPREM JEWELLERY




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### COPENHAGEN FASHION WEEK: A WEEK OF MONOCHROME

openhagen fashion week Autumn Winter collection kicked off with a polite bang that only Copenhagen can accomplish with its egalitarian roots and fully sustainable fashion shows. The Late January event had a lot of the heavyweights of the Scandinavian fashion industry. From Malene Birger to Barbara I Gongini, the catwalks were full of notable and consistent performers who are the standard bearers of the Scandinavian fashion industry that has always
